Portage Health Foundation Scholarship

What the scholarship offers:

Portage Health Foundation offers \$30,000 in health-science scholarships to local students. \$10,000 per school (NMU, MTU, GCC). Students who are eligible for consideration shall originate from Baraga, Houghton, Keweenaw, or Ontonagon counties, seek a degree in the health sciences, demonstrate financial need, maintain at least a 2.5 GPA, and be enrolled full-time.

Who is this for:

This scholarship is for students who attended high school in Baraga, Houghton, Keweenaw, or Ontonagon schools. These students must be attending Michigan Tech, Northern Michigan, or Gogebic College to be eligible.

How to apply:

School administrators will review applications and make recipient selections for their respective students. Students should contact their school's financial aid office for more information. Non-traditional students are encouraged to apply. Many additional opportunities at Michigan Technological University are also available, especially for those from our four-county community. 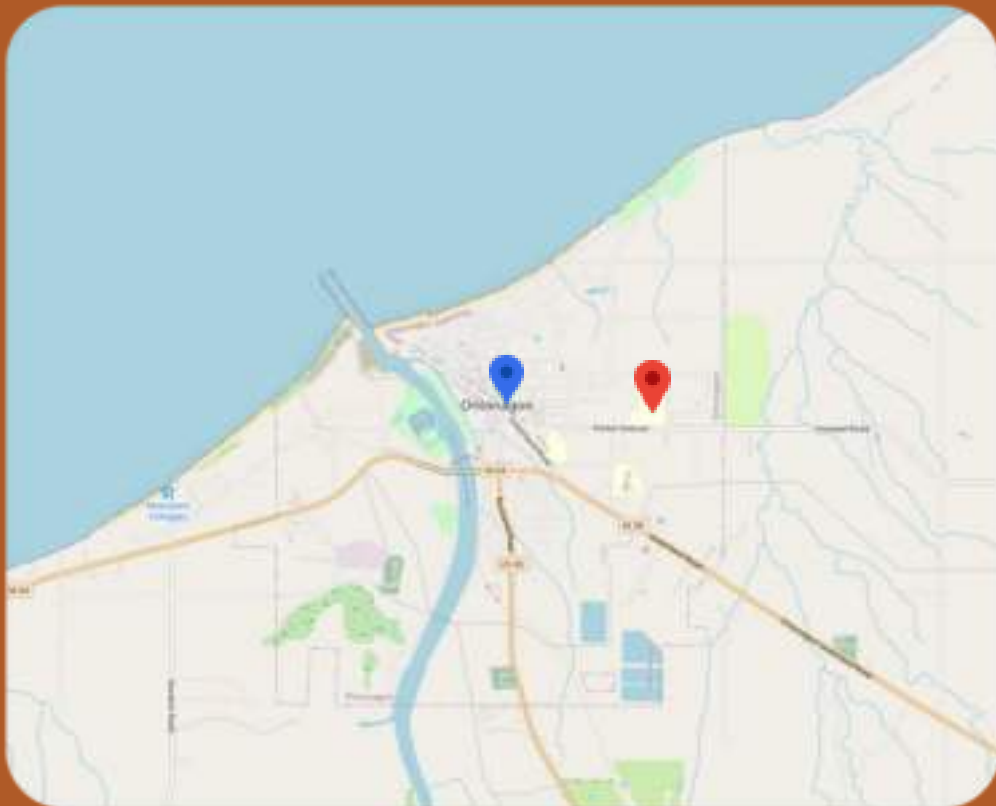

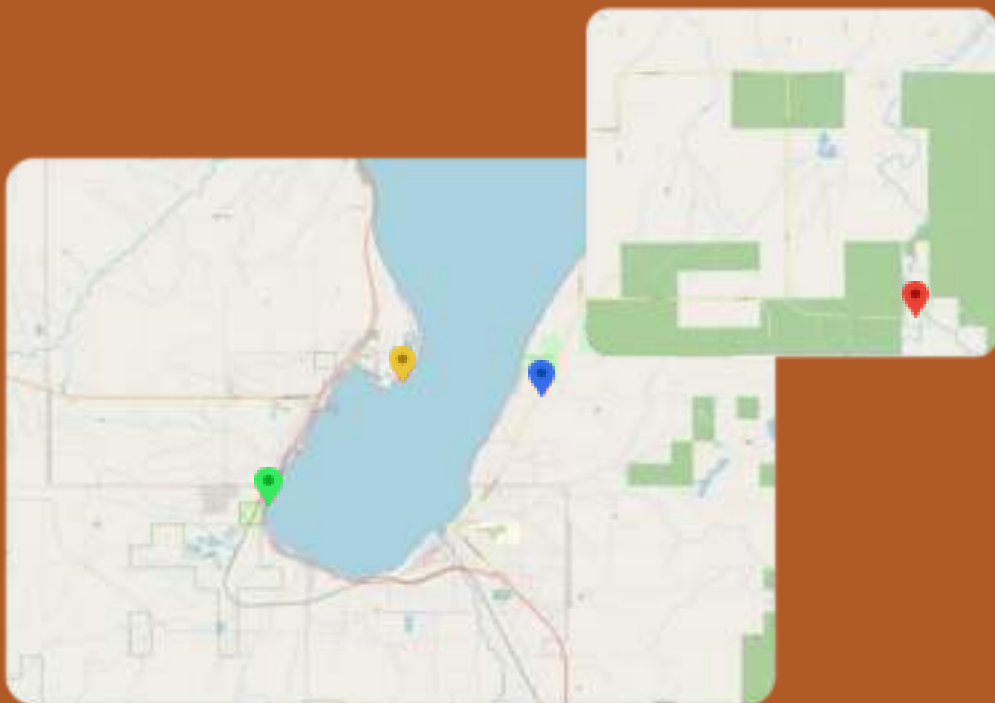

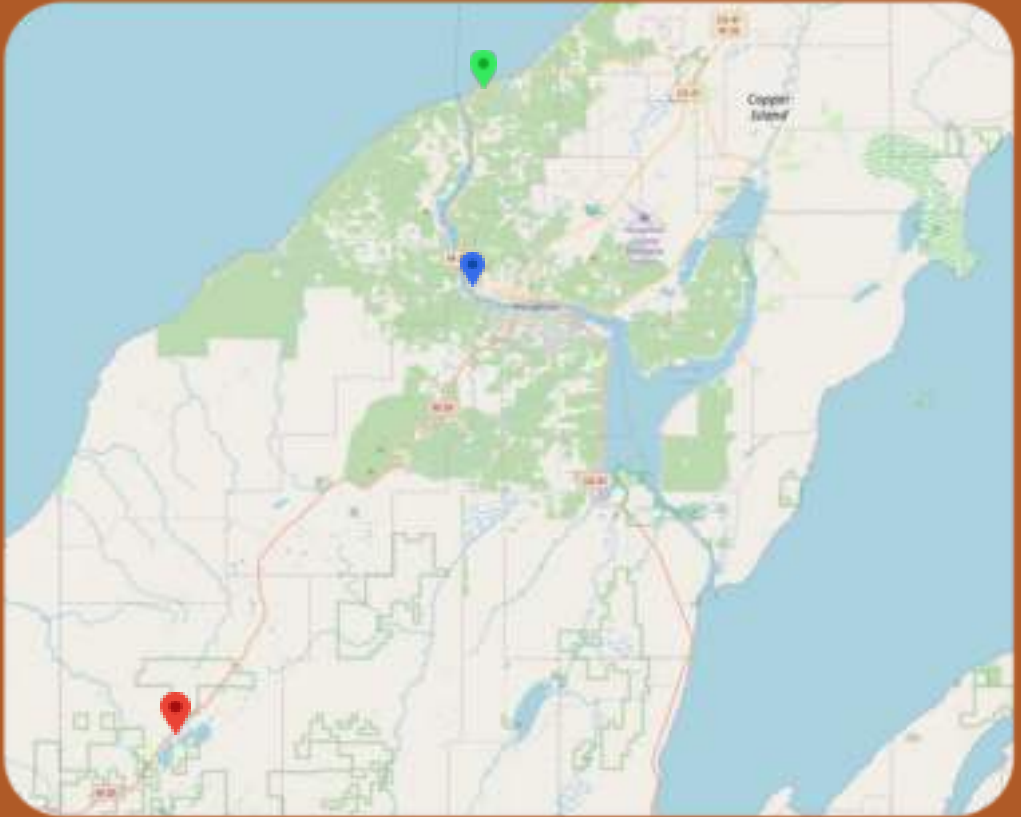

Eagle River Lower Falls

The falls are on the site of the original Lake Superior Fuse Company and remains of the dam still span most of the 60-foot wide river. Water drops over the dam in a straight sheet. There is a parking area and pedestrian bridge just off of M-26 for easy viewing.



Jacob's Falls

This waterfall is visible from the road. This small falls has a total drop of about 40 feet. Trails run up the side of the steep rock into woods upstream.



Manganese Falls

Address: Manganese Rd, Copper Harbor, MI 49918

Manganese Falls is a short walk on a trail along the top of a deep gorge to a viewing area at the trails end. The water drops at least 45 feet from the top of the rocky gorge to the bottom.



Silver River Falls

Address: Hwy M-26, Eagle Harbor, MI 49950

These falls are along M-26 near the western base of Brockway Mountain Drive. There is a small roadside park with picnic tables and grills located just across M-26.



Gratiot River County Park

Address: Gratiot River Shortcut Road, Allouez, MI 49805

Gratiot River County Park covers 222 acres and 8,489 feet of Lake Superior Shoreline along with 1/2 mile of the Gratiot River. Hunting and fishing are permitted.

Lake Fanny Hooe is a 227 acre lake with a maximum depth of 40 feet. The lake is a good walleye lake but also has brook trout, splake, smallmouth bass, and largemouth bass. There is a public access site and boat launch in Fort Wilkins State Park along with camping facilities.



Manitou Island Light Station Preserve

The preserve is open to the public for rock collecting, kayaking, bird watching, and visiting the light station grounds. A wooden dock is located about half a mile to the west of the light station. The light station buildings are generally not open to the public except under prior arrangements with the Keweenaw Land Trust.

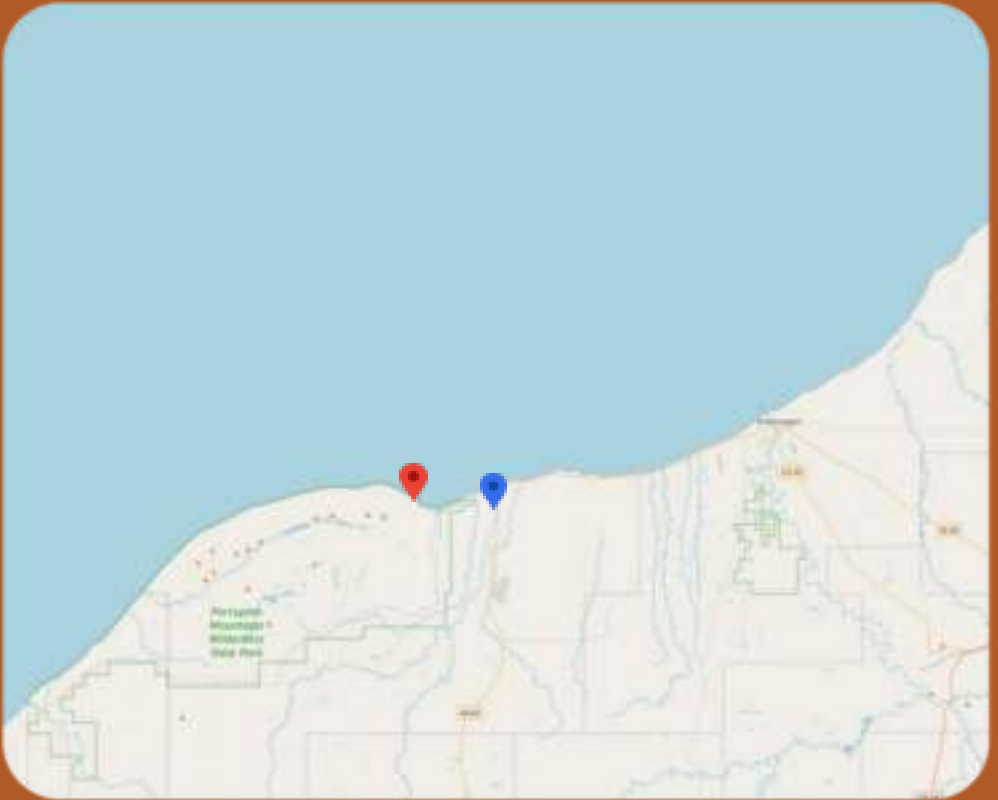
