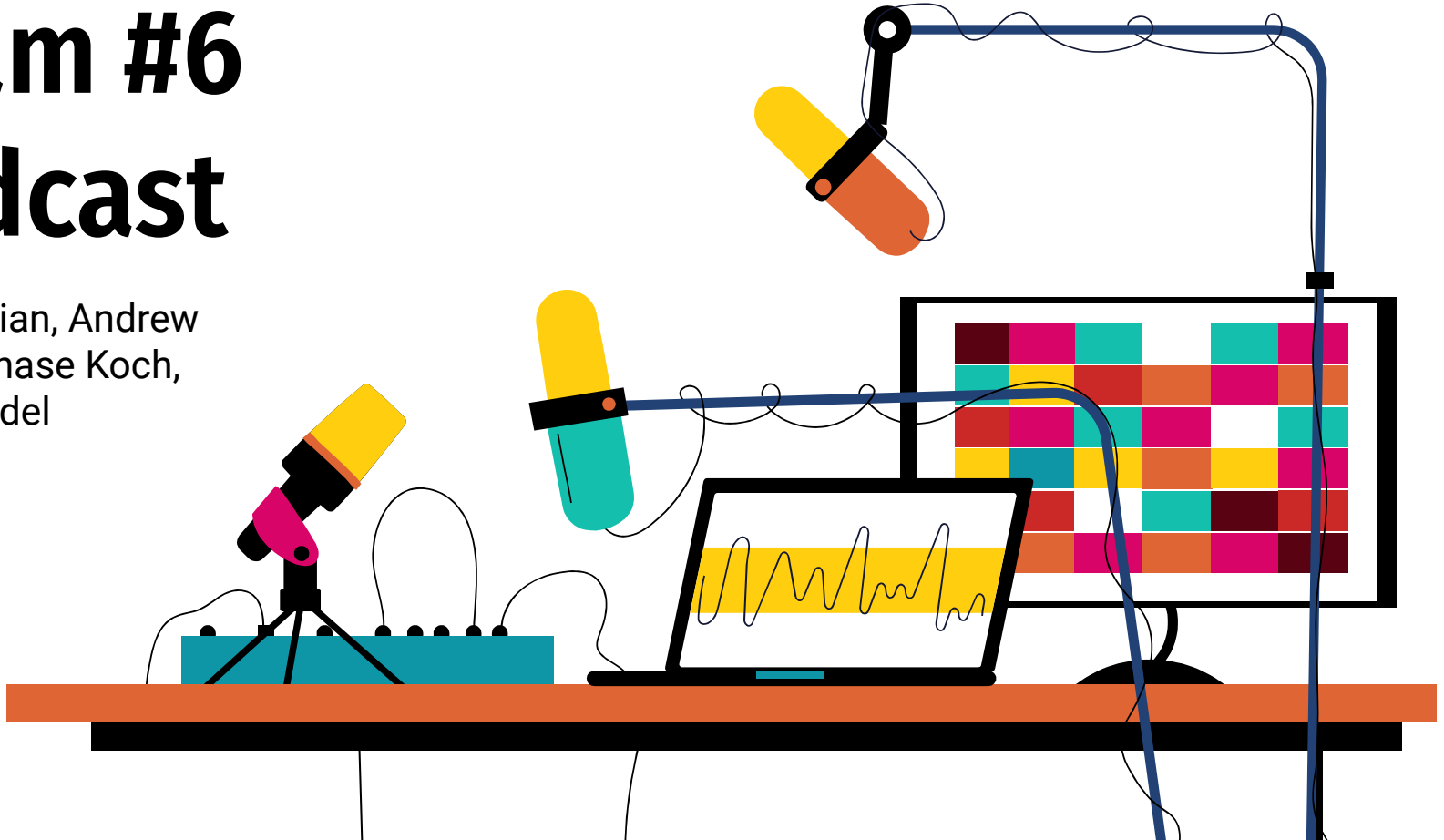

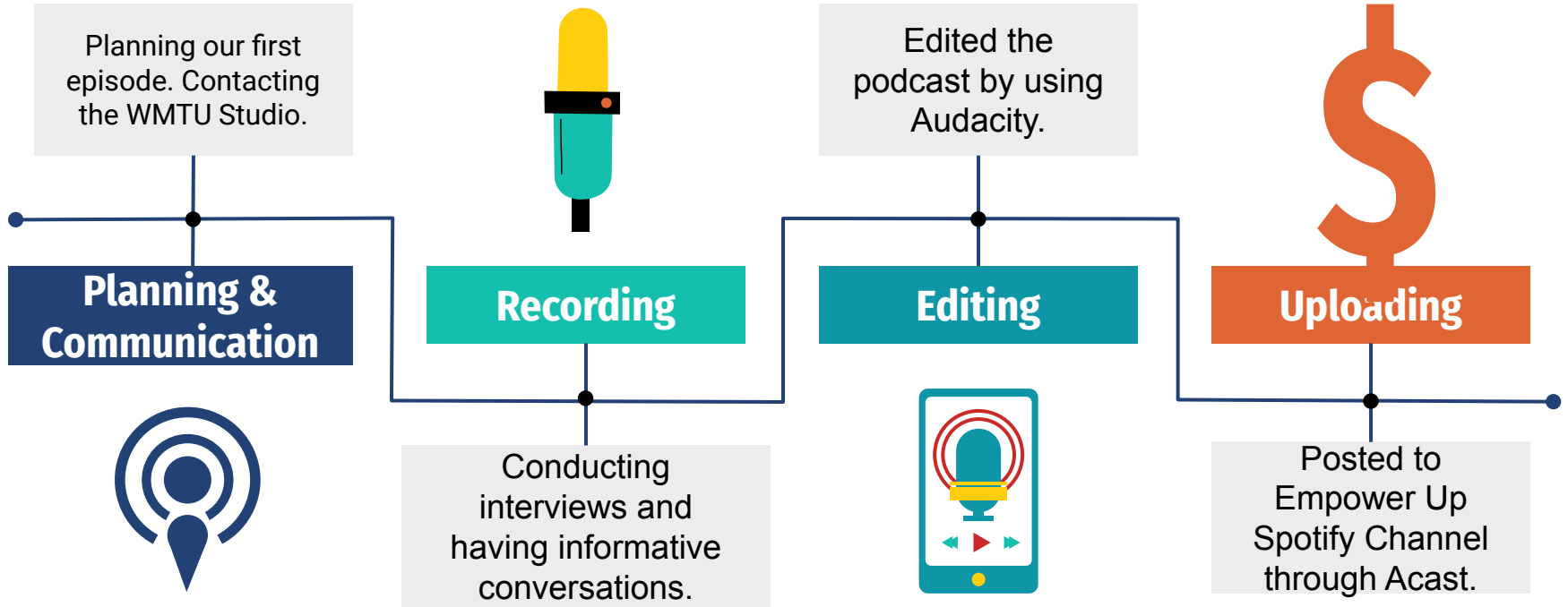

We discussed some important topics when it comes to navigating money, saving spending and budgeting.

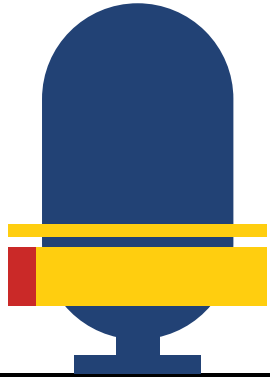
Mrs. Marie Cleveland

Team Dynamics Concepts



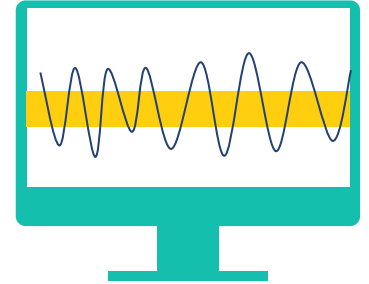
Communication

Understanding Our Roles & Responsibilities

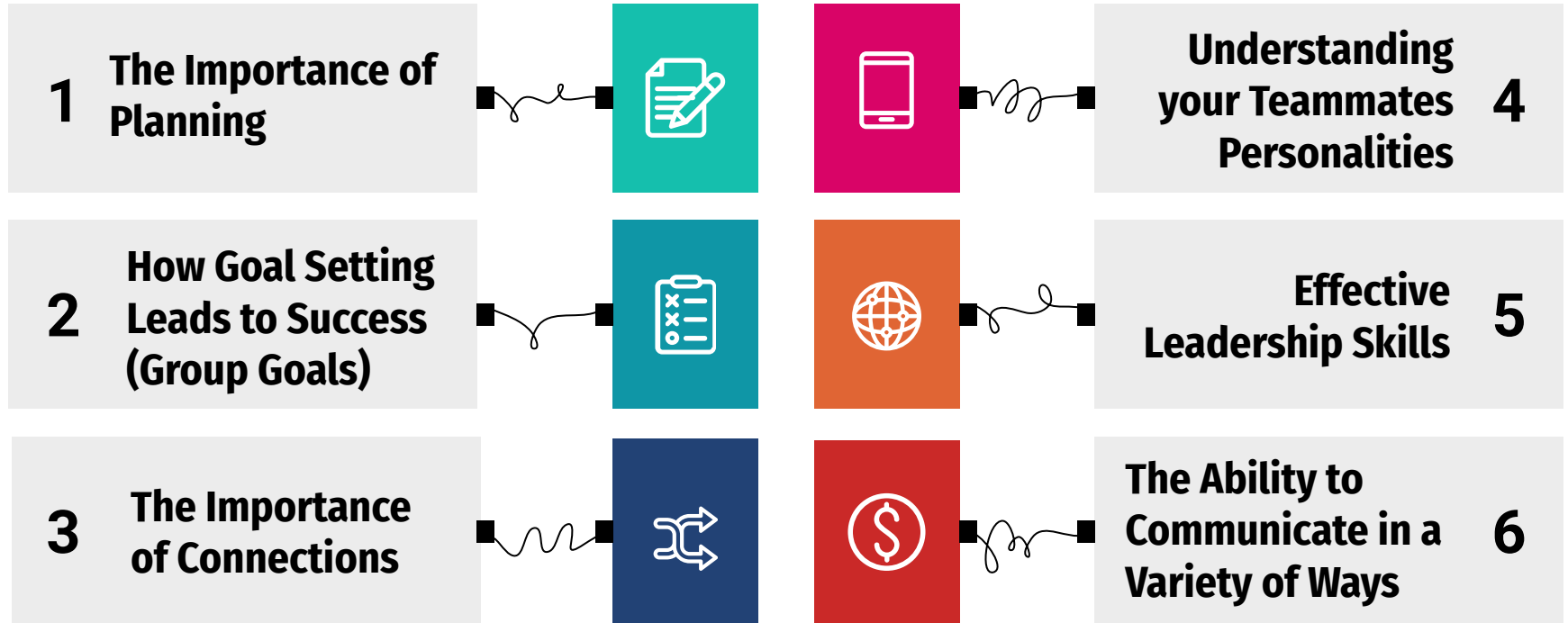
The concept of understanding each of our roles played a vital part into the success of our team.

- The backbone on investing and how it can set you up for retirement later in life

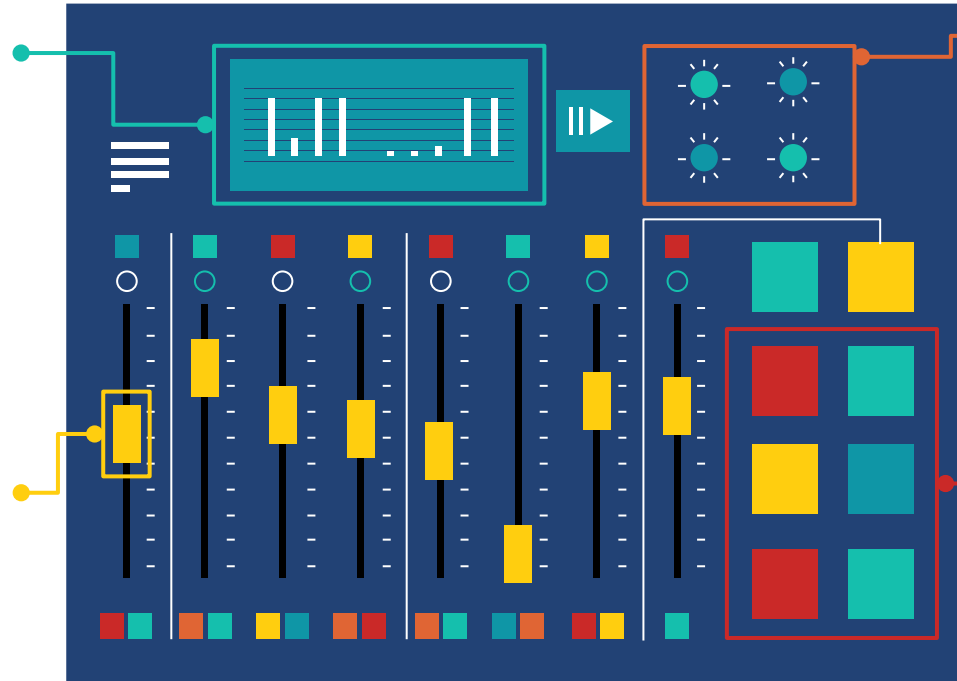
Civic Engagement
